International Aid Serving Kids is a global advocacy children organization that works with local families and a variety of partners to support orphan and abandoned children in need of health care, education, food, and other kinds of assistance. We invite you to serve as a volunteer in one of the following task forces:

Advertising Serve as an advisory board member for media campaign; write radio ads, television ads, and news releases; design posters and fliers.

Advocacy Gather information regarding regulations, practices, and laws pertaining to the organization's global scope of operation; communicate information to the Board of Directors and other key decision makers; act as a liaison for the organization in the United States and abroad.

Fund-raising Identify and approach current, past, and potential donors and sponsors; plan, organize, and carry out activities that will generate donations to support the children the organization is committed to serve.

Grant Writing Research funding agencies; submit grant proposals to request financial resources essential to the accomplishment of the mission of the organization.

Health Work with health care professionals, pharmaceutical companies, and other partners to provide free medical consultations, interventions, immunization, food, medicine, and health education to orphaned and abandoned children and care givers.

Post-Adoption Support Seek to provide a support network to families who have adopted orphaned and abandoned children from foreign countries.

Recruitment Invite individuals from diverse national, ethnic, racial, and religious backgrounds to become volunteers, serve in committees; assist with organization activities as needed.

Sponsorship Identify and approach potential sponsors; help maintain an ongoing relationship between sponsors, children, and foster families; translate letters and documents as well as mail letters and photos.

Technology Create, maintain, update, and review the organization Web site; provide technical assistance.

Community Education Assist in creating presentations about the organization's scope of action; contact individuals and businesses to schedule the presentations.

Recognition Identify achievements within the organization; as well as identify sources of donations; show acknowledgment to individuals and donors in various ways.

Record Hold a journal of pertinent events related to the organization, membership records, and a list of past and current donors.
